RE: Virtual Courtroom Update

Effective May 24, 2021: Judges will be assigned into groups of 2-3 judges. This change in procedure will allow judges to conduct “on the record” fully live, hybrid or virtual proceedings in their assigned courtroom on their assigned day. Judge off days would be used for virtual in chambers conferences. 4 judge groups comprising of 2 judges each will have every other day on the record. 2 judge groups each comprising of 3 judges will have every 3rd day on the record. Judge Berkowitz presiding over AP1 & AP3 will continue to be on the record every day.

Chambers will continue to schedule matters in individual time slots within the shared calendar. Chambers to advise the parties the time slot to appear in the open Team link
